Speaking of helping our students, I would highly encourage any 5th-12th grade students and families to attend our "Rules of the Road" (Preteen-Teen Healthy Habits) Family Engagement Night. PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF JUNIORS AND SENIORS...PLEASE TAKE NOTE!

All juniors and seniors will be attending an Education Quest college planning and financial aid session on October 2 here at Friend Public School. An informational letter will be sent home with students the middle of September. Parents and guardians -- you are encouraged to join us!

The college planning and financial aid session will run from 10:00 am to approximately 10:45 a.m. in the media center. Juniors will then be excused to class, and the seniors will take part in Apply2College Day from 11:00 to 12:15.

Juniors and seniors have been encouraged to create an account on EducationQuest.org and start exploring all this organization has to offer, including information about careers and colleges.

Juniors and seniors have also been encouraged to schedule a college visit soon!

- Juniors are allowed one excused absence for a college visit. It's never too early to start looking!
- Seniors are allowed two excused absences for college visits. I highly encourage them to get one in ASAP since they'll be taking part in Apply2College Day on October 2.
- Parent permission forms for college visits are due BEFORE the student is gone from school or the absence will not be considered excused. Forms are available in the office.

IMPORTANT TEST DATES

October 30, 2024 - invited Juniors take the PSAT

November 13, 2024 - all Sophomores take the PreACT

• This assessment predicts student performance on the ACT and offers career-interest information to students, parents, and teachers. It also helps ensure students take the best classes to prepare them for college and their options after high school.

December 4, 2024 - all Sophomores take the ASVAB

March 25, 2025 - all Juniors take the ACT

Seniors are highly encouraged to retake the ACT between now and December to make sure they have the highest score possible to impact potential financial aid and scholarships.

SENIOR PARENT/GUARDIAN WORKSHOP WITH THE COUNSELOR

- Ms. Hottovy will be holding two sessions during parent/teacher conferences so parents & guardians of seniors can learn more about college & careers, deadlines, scholarships, etc.
- Make plans to join us in the media center on October 2 at either 4:00 p.m. or 6:30 p.m.

SCHOLARSHIP NOTES

- Ms. Hottovy often sends scholarship opportunities and college/career information to juniors and seniors through school email. Have a conversation with your son/daughter about checking their email often and practicing good communication skills.
- If your business, organization, or family would like to begin offering a scholarship to this year's graduating seniors at Friend Public School, please contact Ms. Amy Hottovy at your earliest convenience.
- Current scholarship benefactors who wish to make a change to their application form or process
 are also encouraged to contact the school counselor as soon as possible. Thank you for your

- Students and parents are able to see an updated list of scholarship opportunities as they become
 available. Look for the tab called "Scholarship Central" on the school website. At this time, local
 scholarships are not listed, but they will be added throughout the year.
- Seniors have been encouraged to create an account and complete a profile through Education
 Quest to see the MANY scholarship opportunities that exist. They should check the website
 weekly!
